Andrew's wife Polly watched from the sidelines and supported Andrew all the way: "When I saw Andrew half running and limping to the finish line I was so proud of him, and best of all he had a massive smile on his face and he was so pleased to have made it. Andrew is suffering a little now, and he is hobbling round with a big bag of frozen peas on his damaged knee, but he still has the smile on his face."
